ABC Recycling

- * Canadian company with Canadian scrap and waste, exporting to Bellingham
- * 25 year lease for a metal pile taking space within our most valuable land

NOISE

- * Crashing metal and beeping - 7am until 3 in the morning
- * Keeps residents awake from Fairhaven to Lettered Streets
- * Its time for a NOISE POLICY THAT WORKS

WATERFRONT

- * Massive Pile is has no buffer between the Boardmill building, and is across the street from the Millworks building
 - * 83 workforce housing units - Day care for 100 children

POLLUTION

- * Prevailing Winds blow red dust plumes directly toward Millworks, Playground, Apartments, Trackside, Pump Track and Hotels
- * Lead, Zinc and Copper have been found in stormwater
- * Environmental review was bypassed
- * Metal Piles are a known carcinogen source and a fire hazard

LAND USE

- * City chose 20.37.420.E10 - Barge Loading Facility
 - ** True Land Use - 20.37.420.F11 - Recycling Collection and Processing Facility
- * Waterfront is a joint partnership between the City and the Port
 - ** City leaders did not know about the Metal Pile until complaints poured in

JOBS

- * Only 6 'Full Time Equivalent' - Union jobs
- * ABC quotes 60 Longshoremens load the ship. Labor who live and have jobs elsewhere are not "Jobs!"

METAL SHREDDER!

- * Location surrounded by Birchwood neighborhood, a vulnerable population
- * Possibly hazardous waste to our landfills
- * Lead and Zinc along with PCBs and VOCs released during shredding
- * 40 trucks a day would travel between the Shredder and the Waterfront
- * Heavy Metals, lead and zinc, would hitch a ride in the truck bed and on tires, through Bellingham
